Free for Mac users, it is an industry standard Digital Audio Workstation (DAW) with a wide array of onboard electronic instruments, an extensive loop library, effects, processors, and the capability to record audio without external gear. Private lessons help you with personalized walkthroughs of specific features, feedback on your work, basic music theory and production concepts, as well as regular deadlines to help motivation.
